

SUMMER ARTS CAMP ... JUST FOR KIDS!

Arts are a big deal in Livingston County

After a successful first year, Genesee Valley Council on the Arts will rerun its Summer Arts Camp for kids. The hands-on program is multidisciplinary and brings in specialists Glenn McClure (musician and composer), Patricia Lewis-Browne (actor), Roy Grisewood (artist), and Kathryn Hollinger (arts administrator). Using the county's New Deal easel painting collection as the basis, these adults will help the children explore the historical period as well as the art. Drawing, painting, making music, acting, and fun camp activities like boondoggle, games and singing will be part of the week. The camp wraps up with a reception and show for families.

Space is limited and advance registration is required. Camp is open to children age 9-13 and runs 9am-4pm, Monday-Friday, July 28-August 1. Fee is \$150/week, which includes snacks. A sibling discount is available. Before and after activities are available for an additional cost. Camp takes place on the Livingston County Campus in Mount Morris ... at Al Lorenz Park and the arts council office. Campers will be asked to bring a bag lunch every day.
